Sir,

As Central Government by notification, constituted a Commission, to be known as the National Commission for Homoeopathy, to exercise the powers conferred upon, and to perform the functions assigned to it, under NCH Act 2020. As per section 59 (2) of NCH Act, 2020, following has been stated:

“Notwithstanding the repeal of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act 1973, the educational and medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and the rules and regulations made there under shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made there under: Provided that anything done or any action taken as regards the educational and medical standards and requirements under the enactment under repeal and the rules and regulations made there under shall be deemed to have been done or taken under the corresponding provision of this Act and shall continue in force accordingly unless and until superseded by anything or by any action taken under this Act”.

2) As per provision in the Act, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy has been constituted with the mandate to grant permission to the existing and new medical institution of Homoeopathy. Accordingly, it is to inform you that all the relevant documents and video submitted by your college Inspection dated 20/06/2022 & 21/06/2022, and the inspection for LOP has been conducted on 17/08/2022 were examined by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.

3) On careful consideration of the report, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board has arrived at the following conclusion:-

4) That the applicant has set up a New Homoeopathic Medical College with the component of staff, infrastructure, equipment and instruments and other facilities where as the College has to take urgent and time bound steps to implement Minimum Standard Requirements of the Homoeopathy College and attached Hospital as prescribed by the National Commission for Homoeopathy for conducting BHMS course in Homoeopathy. College is required to fulfill the following deficiencies:

- College should provide copy of renewal letter of registration from Health Department.

- Form 16 is not from Traces Portal.


5) After considering the provisions of NCH Act 2020 and its relevant Regulations, Permission is issued to OMAR Homoeopathic Medical College & Research Centre, Jamia Islamia Ishaatul Uloom Jamia Campass, Molgi Road, Akkalkuwa, Dist. Nanourbar-425415 with intake capacity from 100 seats in UG (BHMS) course for the academic year 2022-23. The Principal is directed to fulfill the deficiencies within 30 days and an affidavit in this regard may be submitted to the Medical Assessment Board within a period of one week.

6) All admissions in Under Graduate course shall be through NEET only. It is further informed that, minimum 15% seats of the permitted intake capacity of BHMS course shall be treated as All India quota. The counseling for seats under All India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling Authority of State / UT Government as designated by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling Authority of that State / UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for All India quota or student admitted there under.

7) The category wise list of selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board as per rules.

8) The college has to comply with the full requirements of NCH Act 2020 and its relevant Regulations for conducting the course. All deficiencies observed, has to be rectified within 30 days' time from the date of issue of this permission letter. Compliance report shall be submitted by the college to Medical Assessment and Rating Board accordingly. Subsequently, the Board shall verify the compliance well in time and may conduct Online/Physical inspection for verification of compliance as per the HCC (MSR) Regulation, 2013.







Jamia Islamia Ishaatul Uloom, Omar Homoeopathic Medical College and Research Centre, Ranjani, Ta: Ghansawangi Dist.: Jalna- 431297, Maharashtra has submitted an application for permission for sanction of 100 seats in BHMS course for the academic year 2023-24. The College has submitted the Part 1 information in which the entire functional profile has been narrated. MARBH has conducted Inspection on 12.07.2023 and 13.07.2023 and shortfalls have been observed on examination of inspection report. MARB has examined the profile of the College as to whether the college fulfils the Minimum Standard requirements to be fulfilled as per the prevailing regulations under NCH Act 2020.

As per the shortfalls made by MARBH, following lacunae are to be rectified with immediate rectification of the shortfalls. College shall fulfil all functional requirements as per the Minimum Standard requirements as mentioned below.

A. Teaching faculty:-

- a) Total 22 faculty shown in teaching list. At the time of the inspection, only 5 college teaching staff were present whose physically verification indicated the lacunas in the minimum teaching staff 16 for 2nd.year as per requirement of MSR.

Hence in absence of faculty availability/ poor presence, genuine functionality of the college could not be not ascertained.

B. Hospital staff:-

- a) Anaesthetist, radiologist, Yoga expert, physiotherapist, x- ray technician and x- ray attendant are not available against the requirement of on call.
b) Pathologist is on call against full time requirement available.
c) Surgeon and Gynaecologist on part time against fulltime requirement as per MSR.
d) Dietician not available against the requirement of part time.
e) Dresser, 02 nursing staff against 3 and dark room attendant are not available.

C. Hospital details:-

- a) Genuine functionality hospital OPD and IPD is not been demonstrated by hospital which is verified through no patient seen in OPD areas and IPD wards when inspector team visited on 12/07/23 at 10.40 am. It has been also verified by quality of case record keeping in OPD and IPD, its correlation with medicine dispensing register, discharge card and investigation facilities and its record.
- b) As per the OPD registration record on 12/07/23, at 10.52 am, there are 116 patients already registered. These patients were seen from 9 am to 10.52 am as there were no patients seen in the hospital when inspector team visited on 12/07/23, at 10.52 am. It means these number of patients (116) are seen within 112 Mins, it means one patient is seen by attending doctors in less than 1 min. this indicates the data provided/ recorded in the hospital registration system are inappropriate.
- c) OPD and IPD case record Performa with address, contact details, diagnosis, proper illness history, proper analysis and evaluation of the symptoms, repertorization, remedy differentiation, guidelines for prescription and proper follow up details and its interpretation are not been addressed in case records.
- d) Deviation in the patient data is observed in computerized and manual case paper for the same patient in OPD and IPD. This indicates the non- genuine cases in hospital.
- e) OT and Labor room are under-utilized as per the records submitted in OT register and labor room register.
- f) IP/OP dispensing registers and Case registers are not maintained.
- g) IP bill book is verified with IP registers but only 01 patient was discharged on 12th and 13th July 2023, whereas it was shown as 5 patients discharged on each day.
- h) Case records are not submitted against the direction issued from MARB. IPD and OPD case records (copy of one OP and one IP cases of 1st and last day of every month) shall be submitted for verification.
- i) Lab investigation report should be maintained properly in case records.
- j) All follow up attendance should be recorded on the case records.
- k) Disease diagnosis shall be recorded in all case records as per ICD 11 criteria.

Hence in the absence of genuine records, functionality of the collegiate hospital could not be ascertained.

D. Library: Librarian was absent on both days of inspection.

E. College teaching departments:-

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F. Financial details:

- a) 22 Teachers are in acquittance roll.
- b) 05 teaching faculties are in attendance registers.
- c) Form -16 are submitted but not from traces portal.

Hence in absence of availability of documents, genuine presence of the college staff could not be not ascertained.

Considering the above observations, and facilities available, MARB has decided to issue **conditional permission to Jamia Islamia Ishaatul Uloom, Omar Homoeopathic Medical College and Research Centre, Ranjani, Ta: Ghansawangi Dist.: Jalna- 431297, Maharashtra for conducting BHMS course for the academic year 2023- 24 with intake capacity of 60 seats (reduced from 100 seats to 60 seats).**

All the shortfalls observed in your College are fundamental in nature and shall be rectified within a period of 30 days or before counselling initiates whichever earlier, and compliance report shall be submitted to the MARB, failing which the conditional permission issued will be cancelled without further notice.

All admissions shall be made from NEET qualified candidates only. It is further informed that minimum 15% of seats of the permitted intake capacity of BHMS course shall be treated as All India Quota. Counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective Counseling Authority of State/ UT govt as designated by Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85 % seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling authority of the state/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the central govt for All India quota or the student admitted thereunder.

The category wise list of the selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by Medical Assessment and Rating Board.

OMAR Homoeopathic Medical College and Research Center, New Railway Station, Rajni, Tq. Gansawangi, Dist. Jalna-425415 has applied for permission for sanction of 100 seats in BHMS course for the academic year 2025-26. The College has submitted the Part I information in which the entire functional profile has been narrated. MARBH conducted Inspection on 26.06.2025 & 27.06.2025 followed by virtual hearing on 10/07/2025. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board has examined the College as to whether the college fulfils the Minimum Essential Standards as per the prevailing regulations under clauses 26 and 28 of the NCH Act 2020. On careful examination of the report, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board observed the following shortfalls: -

1. Deficiency of Teaching Faculty

In UG - (07 deficiencies)

- 01 Associate Professor in the Department of Human Physiology.
- 01 Professor in the Department of Pathology.
- 01 Professor and 01 Associate Professor in the Department of Surgery.
- 01 Professor and 01 Associate Professor in the Department of Obstetrics & Gynecology.
- 01 Assistant Professor in the Department of Anatomy.

As evident from the above statement, a total number of 07 UG teachers are deficient against the requirement of 40 + 1 for 100 seats UG college (As specified in MES, 2024). Pursuant to F.No.:3-2/MARBH/NCH/2025-26/162-169 dtd. 16/04/2025 issued by MARBH, a college up to 100 seats can avail 10% relaxation against the required number of teachers for Academic Year 2025-26 only. After allowing relaxation of 10%, college still has deficiency of three fulltime teaching faculty. However, such relaxed number of teachers may be appointed at the earliest for smooth conduct of course.

2. In Department of Community Medicine:

- i. Statistical Software is not available.
- ii. Statistical Assistant and Multitasking Staff are not available.

3. Miscellaneous:

- i. Pay scale of all the teaching and non-teaching staff are not according to MES- 2024.

Considering the above observations during inspection and virtual hearing, MARBH has decided to issue **Conditional permission to OMAR Homoeopathic Medical College and Research Center, New Railway Station, Rajni, Tq. Gansawangi, Dist. Jalna-425415 for continuing UG (BHMS) course with intake capacity of 100 seats for academic year 2025 – 26, on the basis of following conditions:-**


- i. Three full-time teaching faculties must be appointed.
- ii. In Department of Community Medicine Statistical Assistant, Multitasking staff must be appointed.
- iii. In the Department of Community Medicine, lack of Statistical Software needs to be met.
- iv. Ensure that the pay scale for all teaching and non-teaching staff comply with the MES-2024 guidelines.

The institute will rectify all the above deficiencies within a month and compliance shall be submitted to MARBH, failing which permission may be withdrawn.

4. All admissions shall be made from NEET qualified candidates only. It is further informed that minimum 15% of seats of the permitted intake capacity of 100 seats for BHMS course shall be treated as All India Quota. Counselling for seats under All India Quota shall be conducted by the Central Government and counselling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling authority of the state/UT designated by Central Government. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Govt. for All India Quota or the student admitted thereunder.
5. The Category wise list of the selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.
